

## Sequencing Practice

Cut the following strips apart and place the events in sequential order.

Teaching tip: These sequencing strips can be used in a cooperative learning structure, during small group instruction, or at a literacy center. Copy them onto tag board or cardstock to make them more durable for a sequencing game. Print them on regular paper if you wish to have the students cut them apart and glue them in order for you to assess later. You could glue each strip to the bottom of a piece of blank paper to be illustrated and made into short sequencing books.
